Contest Rules and Regulations:

- 1. All participants must be using Geophysical Survey Systems, Inc. (GSSI) ground penetrating radar or GSSI electromagnetic induction instruments in picture submission.
- 2. By entering the GSSI Photo Contest (the "Contest"), entrant represents, acknowledges and warrants that the submitted Photograph is original work created solely by the entrant and that no other party has any right, title, claim or interest in the Photograph. The only exception is for photos taken of you, however, you must also provide written consent from the photographer along with your submission. You are further required to comply with all U.S. and international copyright laws, trademark laws, and any and all laws regarding intellectual property both in the United States and in your jurisdiction. You assert that no such laws have been violated when making your submission. You will hold harmless GSSI for any violations in connection with the image(s) submitted.
- 3. No purchase necessary to enter the GSSI Photo Contest for the 2018 GSSI Calendar.
- 4. **Photo Submission:** The Submission cannot have been submitted previously in a promotion of any kind or exhibited or displayed publicly through any means. We reserve the right to reject any photos which we, in our sole and absolute discretion, deem offensive, violation of law or unsuitable in any other manner. GSSI is not required to provide any explanation for the rejection.

Examples of the following types of photos we will reject include the following:

- Pornographic or nude images
- Images promoting illegal drug use
- Images depicting crimes of any nature

Photo Guidelines:

- The Submission must be in JPEG, JPG or PNG format; picture submission must be at least 1,600 pixels wide (if a horizontal image) or 1,600 pixels tall (if a vertical image). Please submit the highest quality image with regard to file size, bit depth and resolution.
- Entrant must provide a high-resolution copy of Submission upon winning. GSSI reserves the right to disqualify incomplete entries and/or entrants who are unable to submit, upon request, a high-resolution image.
- Submissions that have been digitally altered beyond standard optimization (removal of dust, cropping, reasonable adjustments to exposure, color and contrast, etc.) will be disqualified.
- Subjects in submission must be at least 18 years of age. Submissions promoting children will be rejected.

- 5. You retain your rights to your photograph; however, by entering the Contest, you grant the Geophysical Survey Systems, Inc. (and those authorized by GSSI) a royalty-free, world-wide, perpetual, non-exclusive license to publicly display, distribute, reproduce, and create derivative works of the entries, in whole or in part, in any media now existing or later developed, for any GSSI purpose, including, but not limited to, advertising and promotion of GSSI and its website, exhibition, and commercial products, including but not limited to GSSI publications. Any photograph reproduced will include a photographer credit as feasible. GSSI will not be required to pay any additional consideration or seek any additional approval in connection with such uses.
- 6. During the Contest period the general public will be invited to vote for the submission they believe has the most public appeal. Pending compliance with these Official Rules, the ten (10) entrants with the highest-scoring submissions will be deemed a potential Grand Prize winner, and considered our semi-finalists.

A maximum of (3) photographs can be submitted on behalf of any one company/individual, with exception to those companies that have multiple locations as verified by GSSI. In which case, each location may submit a maximum of (3) photographs. A company with multiple locations can be represented by no more than 3 images in the semi-finalist round.

Following the Contest Period, a panel of qualified judges of GSSI staff will determine the Grand Prize winner, 2nd Place Winner and 3rd Place Winner.

7. All photos submitted that abide by the above rules will be entered into the contest pool. Any information obtained via contest submission will not be distributed nor used for any other purpose. One Grand Prize winner, One 2nd Place Winner, and One 3rd Place Winner will be chosen on September 22, 2017 and will be notified via Facebook message or email and promoted on the GSSI page. Winners must reply within 5 business days to maintain eligibility. If winners do not reply within 5 business days of notification, prize will be surrendered. The Grand Prize will not be given to the same participant in this yearly contest for two consecutive years in a row. The prior year's Grand Prize winner may only be eligible to win second or third place prize in this year's contest. All decisions of the Contest will be final and binding.

Contest Period: The GSSI Photo Contest begins at noon EST Monday, August 14, 2017 and ends at midnight EST, Wednesday, September 20, 2017.

Prizes: The winners will be chosen by September 22, 2017. GSSI is not responsible for prize utility, quality or otherwise. Taxes and fees, if any, are the sole responsibility of winners. Winners shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless GSSI, its affiliates, subsidiaries, parents, directors, offices, and employees from and against any liabilities arising from or regarding taxes owed on prizes and/or injury caused by said prizes.
